Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (BUET) has announced the admission circular for the foreign nationals at undergraduate level for academic session 2010-2011 under self-finance scheme. There are 26 (twenty-six) seats for foreign students in undergraduate level. However, a maximum 10 (ten) students from a single country and a maximum of 05 (five) students in a single department shall be allowed. Details regarding eligibility criteria, procedure of application, cost of study and prescribed application form for foreign students are furnished below. Interested foreign students who fulfill the <u>eligibility criteria</u> can fill out the <u>application form</u> and submit the same to this Embassy by <u>24 December 2010 as the last date of application (deadline to be strictly enforced repeat to be strictly enforced).</u>

Admission of Foreign Nationals at Undergraduate Level For Academic Session 2010-2011

Applications from foreign nationals for admission in the undergraduate courses of this university for the session 2010-2011 should reach the Office of the Registrar of BUET by January 09, 2011. Applicants who passed the Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C.) examination or its equivalent in 2009 or later / GCE A level examination after November 2008 or later are eligible to apply, subject to fulfillment of other conditions.

1. Eligibility criteria

- (a) Foreign nationals having their Higher Secondary Examination or its equivalent examination from foreign education boards / GCE "A" level or its equivalent education in foreign countries shall be considered as 'Foreign' students.
- (b) Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary Examination or its equivalent examination with minimum "B" grades in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English.
- (c) Candidates passing the GCE "O" Level and GCE "A" Level must earn an average of B grade in at least five subjects (including Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English) in GCE "O" Level examination and at least two A grades in the three subjects of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and B grade in the other subject in GCE "A" Level examination.

2. Number of seats

The total number of seats for foreign students in undergraduate level in a single academic session is 26 (twenty six). However, a maximum of 10 (ten) students from a single country and a maximum of 5 (five) students in a single department shall be allowed.

3. Procedure for submission of application

Applications for admission must be submitted through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of their respective countries to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. The relevant documents of educational qualifications and 3 (three) recently taken color photographs of the candidate should be included with the application form. After receiving the applications, the Admission Committee will select the eligible candidates for Admission in order of merit.

4. Cost of study

The tuition and other fees for undergraduate studies for students from SAARC countries will be charged as per regulations of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. The students from non-SAARC countries will be charged US\$ 50 (Fifty) only per credit.

- 4. All certificates and mark sheets essentially be attested by the Foreign Ministry of the respective countries of the candidates without which no application will be entertained.
- Only for MBBS and BDS courses the applicant must enclose a non-refundable demand draft of US \$ 50 or Taka 3,000/-
